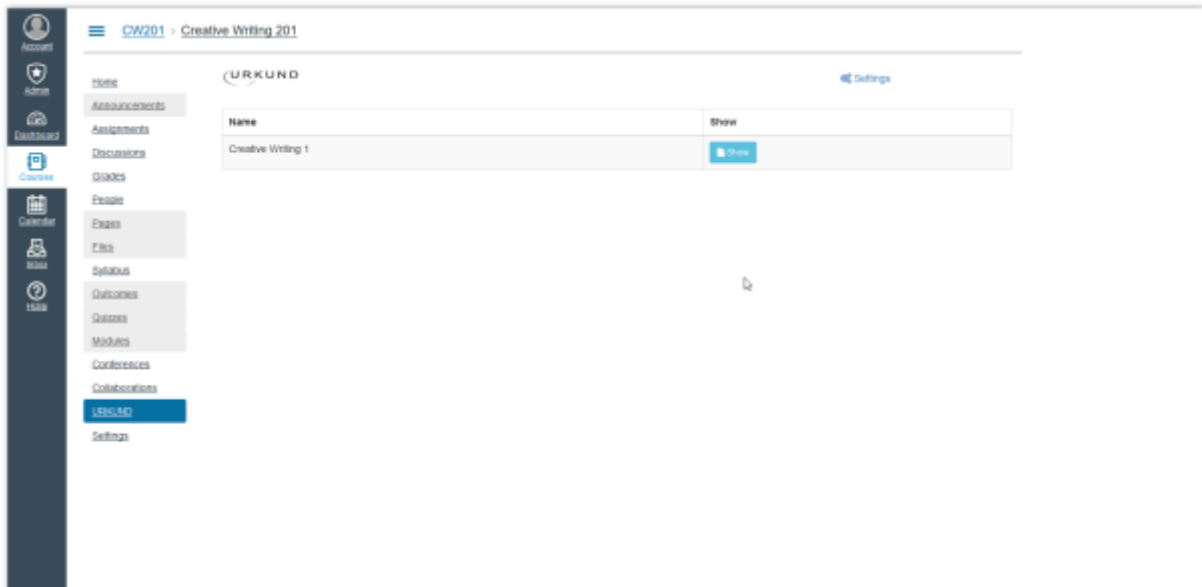
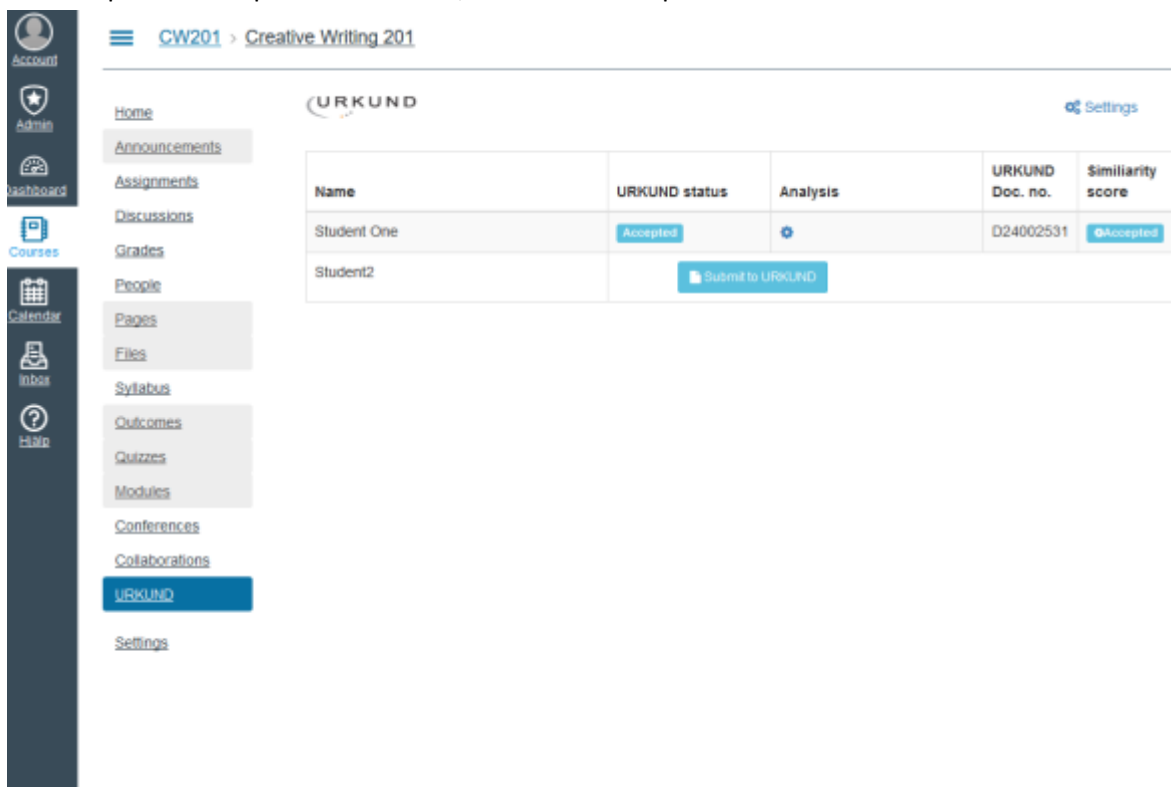


Using URKUND in Canvas - Viewing the Results of URKUND's Scan (Teacher)

1) In the relevant Course, select URKUND on the left side of the screen and then select the Assignment for which you want to see the URKUND results.




2) You can now see the results for each student. If the student uploaded to the wrong upload tab, the teacher will see a "submit to URKUND" button. Pressing it will send the student document to URKUND for plagiarism checking. In the example below, the document is still being analysed. To see an example of a completed document, see the next step.






3) You can now see that the document has been analysed. In this example, you can see that the percentage score is on the far right of the screen. A warning has been given for potential text tampering; this is shown by the warning triangle in the fourth column. Clicking on the analysis report symbol in the third column will open the report in a new browser window/tab.
